Vehicles shall be equipped with dome light affixed to cab roof, operational while performing work. Vehicles shall also be fitted with identification number affixed to cab door. (Magnetic number shall be provided by Town).

Contractor must obtain, at their expense, all licenses and insurance and deliver said information to the Town of Ludlow Department of Public Works necessary for the lawful completion of all related work. These will include, but not be limited to, vehicle registration, operator's license and vehicle insurance papers.

Contractor will have in place prior to start of work public liability and property damage insurance, all of which will cover the period of work from start to finish. The public liability shall be of a monetary value no less than \$300,000 per person per occurrence and cover all damages arising out of bodily injury or death. The property damage liability insurance shall be of a monetary value no less than \$100,000 per occurrence and cover all properties damaged within the course of work.

The undersigned hereby agrees to the above-listed rates for use of the indicated equipment with driver during the upcoming snowplowing season, and further certifies this equipment will be on-call and available for the agreed purpose of snowplowing. The Contractor shall save the Town harmless from, growing out of, in any way connected with the performance of this Agreement, or caused by and negligence on want of care on the part of said Contractor or any Sub-Contractor or of any person employed by the said Contractor Sub-Contractor.

Re: SNOWPLOWING PROCEDURES

The following snowplowing procedures shall be followed.

1. When snowplowing at intersections, DO NOT PACK SNOW INTO STREET CORNERS. The piling of snow at corners causes problems with the following:  
Piled snow interferes with sight distance for cars entering and exiting the intersecting streets.

Piled snow makes it difficult for residents to clear sidewalks and crosswalks. September 17, 2020

2. Do NOT use private property or driveways to turn your equipment around.
3. Do NOT plow across main streets while plowing side streets.
4. All breakdown time MUST be called in to the dispatcher, 583-5625, ext. 1408
5. Also, call in upon your return to your plowing route.
6. Once a street is started, complete the entire street before moving on to the next street. No single passes to open a street will be allowed, unless authorized by the DPW.
7. Snow will be pushed to the curb line or as close as reasonably possible. Common sense must be used when plowing near or adjacent to private fences, garages and mailboxes. YOU are responsible for damage caused by your plowing.
8. Upon completion of your plowing route, remove windrows of snow crossing side streets caused by the plowing of main streets.
9. You must report to the DPW dispatcher before starting your route, unless you are told otherwise. Report back to the DPW dispatcher upon completion of your route to sign out.
10. Contracted equipment and rented plows are prohibited from conducting any work on private Property. Violations will result in immediate termination including all equipment from the vendor. Only Town authorized use of equipment on private property for emergency responses.
11. The Contractor shall be entitled to a paid 30-minute break/downtime for every eight (8) hours worked. The Contractor shall notify the Town dispatcher when utilizing this period.
