Glass  Empty and rinse. Discard lids in trash. Plastics  Empty and rinse. Caps and lids OK if left on.  ONLY containers smaller than 2.5 gallons are recyclable.  food containers: margarine, yogurt, cooking oil, condiments, peanut butter  beverage bottles and jugs: soda, water, juice, milk  detergent bottles, dish soap bottles  personal care bottles: shampoo, soap, etc.  clear plastic clamshells (no black or Styrofoam)  Cartons  Empty, rinse, & flatten. Throw away caps & straws.
