

Chair Updates

- Linda (Chapman) Collette was invited to the Ludlow Rotary Meeting to talk up the 250th
 Celebration. The Rotary presented a check for \$250.00.
- Peoples Bank donated \$30,000. This will be in \$10,000 increments for 3 years.
- Luso Federal Credit Union asked Linda (Chapman) Collette about a \$10,000.00 donation they had made to the committee. Linda stated the committee never received it. The Luso Federal Credit Union sent documents to Linda so she could check into this. After doing some checking at the Ludlow Town Hall, Linda found that the \$10.000, was placed in the Celebrate Ludlow Account by mistake. She was able to identify the check as the memo on the check had 250th Celebration Committee. Linda contacted BOS DeBarge who contacted Mark Strange, Town Administrator and the money was switched to the 250th Celebration Committee account on Tuesday May 30, 2023.
- Vanishing Valley Brewery is on board for the Lupa Zoo event and will sell beer to the 250th celebration committee at a cost of \$80/case. The committee will make a profit of \$3.88 a can.
- Memorial Day Parade had lots of compliments and was very organized. The parade ran about 40 minutes.
- Linda (Chapman) Collette will be going to the Lions Meeting on June 14, 2023, to talk about upcoming events being held. The 250th is hoping the Lions Club will volunteer to do the cooking for A Breakfast with Santa this year.
- Boys & Girl Club will be holding a Slide into Summer Event. They would like to have flyers of upcoming events to hand out.
- An article on the Lupa Zoo event will be in The Register along with a QR Code so people can buy tickets online.
- Lucy Palmeria and Kathy (Hurley) Ouimette did all the invites for the Parade- Bruce complimented on what a great job they did. The Ludlow Sea Lions need to be organized marching in the parade Candy NEEDS TO BE HANDED OUT NOT THROWN.

- Town Munis report- \$62, 392. 29
- Our Balance was \$62,742. 77. This balance does not include the \$10,000 from Luso Federal Credit Union.
- There is a difference of \$350.48.
- Linda (Chapman) Collette sent in invoice for Flags to be paid. Will give Denise the paperwork on this invoice.

Parade Budget

- \$50,000 down to \$25,000 for music. Is hoping Polish National Credit Union will sponsor 2 acts. This would put \$17,000back in the parade budget.
- Fletcher Sewer and Drain donate \$250.00.
- Linda (Chapman) Collette, Bruce Durand and John Diotalevi will be going out to ask for donations and sponsors.
- Bruce talked to Mike White from the Shriners a group of 60+ Shriners will cost \$3000/\$5000.
- Ballon-Souvenir- popcorn vendors pay a fee to the town so they can sell their goods at the parade.
- No Vendors will be allowed at block party.
- Permission to bring the parade committee to East Longmeadow on 4th of July was accepted. This will be a good chance for the parade committee to see how the 250th will need to be handled.
- The Friends of the 250th paid for parade shirts. The parade committee will pay for the embroidery.
- A question was asked as to who the liaison to the Friends of the 250 non-profit group was. Linda (Chapman) Collette stated she would be.

- Bruce will be asking Keith Ouimette of Mainly Drafts about using a wagon for the 250% OF LUDLOW celebration committee in the parade.
