He is on board but would like a detailed list of what would be expected from student volunteers. Would like to see a week of school dedicated to the 250th birthday of Ludlow. Something to do with teacher cooperation. Ludlow Coloring created by Karen Pilon & Maggey Lavoie will be given to the 250th committee to hand out to the elementary school. Roz Sousa is working on a Spark the fireworks program that will allow school children to fill cans in their classroom with loose change to go towards the firework fund. Possible pizza party to the classroom that raises the most money.

Picnic/ Denise- Couple of meetings, not very good attendance. Good accounting of who's on what subcommittee. Need to reach out to groups to get their subcommittee reports MMA B coming in with electricity on Thursday before the picnic will work with DPW.

Bands under contract, Aqua String Band \$8500, CT Hurricanes \$4000, Great American Band \$2500, Hallamore Clydesdale \$7000, Hog River Dixie \$1000, Holyoke Caledon \$1000, LHS \$1000, Baird Middle School \$1000, Ludlow Community Band \$500, Melha Shriners \$5500, Polish String \$8500, Woodland String \$8000. The embroidery on the shirts cost \$159.90. Quality beverage needs to contact Budweiser about the Budweiser Clydesdales, classified fee. Memorial Day Parade route has been changed to starting at Ludlow High School on Chapin St take a right on to East St. and proceed to Gazebo Park.

Denise asked the committee to sponsor a veterans coffee hour and a Veterans Luncheon. Bruce made a motion to support the Ludlow Veterans with a coffee hour and a Luncheon. The fees would be paid for form the Friends of the 250th. Derek 2nd the motion.
