Treasurer's Report

- from Regina Stanek- To date there is \$22,249.96. Still some outstanding bills to be paid

to Ric Tereso band Emotion, and for Last Night banners and signage, also to Linda for reimbursement for signs

and misc. purchases. We are still waiting for the state to send us \$25K and for the town's \$25K that was

approved at the Town Meeting in May to be deposited into our account. Kathy and Regina are following up.

Last Night

- Linda - So far, we've received about 50+ vendor application requests.

Linda - placed an order for signage this week in the amount of \$399.00 from Dope Marketing.

Linda placed the banner order for Last Night to the Sheriff's Dept. The DPW will hang the banners when they

arrive in approximately a week.

Bruce Marshall, WARE, is available to broadcast live and DJ music on Feb. 22

nd

at a cost of \$1,850.00. We

discussed whether we need this as the cost is a bit higher than we expected. Bruce Durand made a

motion to try to negotiate the cost to not more than \$1,200. Linda will call Bruce Marshall to discuss it. This

motion was seconded by David Sady. All in favor, motion passed.

We are secured for the company Pyrotechnics for fireworks, and we'll need to send in deposits and or payments

soon. They have notified Linda that they have met with local and state Fire Marshall's and have received

approval to launch them from behind LHS. We were also told that they can launch a larger shell display for an

additional cost, for a total of approximately \$7K.

Linda, Kathy and Bruce will meet with LPD and LFD Chiefs to have a plan for security at the event and work with LFD for the bonfire and pyrotechnicians on January 14, 2025. The DPW will also be attending.

Music- Linda has secured 2 bands, CCG and Kingdom of Jones. They'll play in the auditorium for a couple of hours each, for \$400.00 for each band.

Food- DHI will participate, Adelei Bernard, teacher at LHS, has committed to serve baked potatoes and potato soup.
