

The regular meeting of the Board of Health was held on Tuesday, May 9, 2017. Neil D. Paquette, Chairman and Elinor Kelliher, M.D., Member were present with Office Assistant Carolyn Rogowski recording the minutes. Timothy J. Fontaine, Secretary was absent. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Paquette.

Payroll schedules and bills were signed as approved by Board members. Minutes of the April 11, 2017 & April 25, 2017 meetings were read by Board members. Motion made by Dr. Kelliher to accept the April 11th & April 25th minutes as written, with Mr. Paquette seconding the motion. All in favor 2-0. Mr. Fontaine will sign the minutes when he comes into the office.

Mike LoSasso came in with a floor plan of Papa Gino's which is taking over the former Boston Market located on the Massachusetts Turnpike West. Mr. LoSasso believes that all food is pre-packaged, but he will check on that. They plan on opening in July. Floor plan was approved by Board members.

Hasam Nandem came in with a revised plan for the Board to review for his business, Basics Mini Mart, located at 190-194 East Street. Mr. Nandem says all food items will be pre-packaged. Mr. Paquette informs Mr. Nandem that he must put FRP material behind the sinks. He plans on opening the 2nd week of July. Floor plan was approved by Board members.

Lorraine Watt from 49 West Avenue came in with a floor plan of her business, Two Roses Tea & Cupcake Company, located at 8 Chestnut Street. Ms. Watt explains that her business is cake and cupcake decorating classes. They will bring their own cake or cupcakes, however she will make and provide the frosting. Because she is making the frosting, she must have a hand sink, a three bay sink, and become Serv Safe Certified. She will be selling other pastries, which will be purchased at Big Y and Randall's. She will also be selling different kinds of teas. Ms. Watt will attend another meeting when her floor plan has been updated.

Email from Human Resources Carrie Ribeiro inquiring whether or not we had a Gas Leak Bylaw. The Board of Health does not have a Gas Leak Bylaw. We will forward this letter to Building Department.

Complaint regarding rats on Moody Street was reviewed. Mr. Paquette will inspect.

Report show that there are chickens on the property but no signs of odor. However, there is a great deal of debris on the property. Will email this report to complainant.
