

The regular meeting of the Board of Health was held on Tuesday, June 13, 2017. Neil D. Paquette, Chairman; Timothy J. Fontaine, Secretary; and Elinor Kelliher, M.D., Member were present with Office Assistant Franci Reyes recording the minutes. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Paquette.

Payroll schedules and bills were signed as approved by Board members. Minutes of the May 23, 2017 meeting was read by Board members. Motion made by Dr. Kelliher to accept the May 23 minutes as written, with Mr. Fontaine seconding the motion. All in favor 3-0.

Samantha Parsons, a State Certified Aesthetician came in to meet with the Board regarding permission for micro blading brows at Hair West which is located at 326 West Avenue. Ms. Parsons was able to elaborate in full detail on the process involving micro blading. She stated that she is passionate about her field of work and has had extensive training and education from the very best. The Board discussed with Ms. Parsons proper sterilization, sanitization and proper disposal of biohazard materials. The Board has recommended for her to add long handles to the handwashing sink to make it hands free, renew CPR Certification and acquire First Aid Certification. Board members would like the make, model, and serial number of the autoclave being used for sanitization of tweezers. The Board has also asked Ms. Parsons to submit copies of all Certifications to the Board of Health and a final inspection of the work area will be completed prior to the start of micro blading. The Board agreed on the Body Art Practitioner's permit fee for \$50.00.

Motion made by Mr. Fontaine, seconded by Dr. Kelliher to accept Mr. Pietras's bid for Septic Installer. All in favor 3-0.

Motion made by Mr. Fontaine, seconded by Dr. Kelliher to re-advertise the Director of Nurses position.
