

The regular meeting of the Board of Health was held on Tuesday, June 27, 2017. Neil D. Paquette, Chairman; Timothy J. Fontaine, Secretary; and Elinor Kelliher, M.D., Member were present with Office Assistant Carolyn Rogowski recording the minutes. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Paquette.

Payroll schedules and bills were signed as approved by Board members. Minutes of the June 13, 2017 meeting was read by Board members. Motion made by Dr. Kelliher to accept the June 13th minutes as written, with Mr. Fontaine seconding the motion. All in favor 3-0.

Henry Lajgas & Elizaeth Koch from Harmony Springs Soda Company which is located on 136 Yale Street came in as regarding the Violation Order issued to them. Due to a complaint made a Certified letter was sent to Harmony Springs regarding the debris on this property. Inspection report submitted by Health Inspector Timothy Mendes shows that there is debris on the property such as pallets, dumpster, etc. In addition, there is a truck blocking any egress in case of an emergency. Mr. Lajgas explains that they purchased the property seven years ago and there was an easement in the purchase agreement. He says that the dumpsters are hidden behind a fence and the truck has been moved. Mr. Paquette and Mr. Mendes will conduct another inspection of 136 Yale Street.

Anne Marie Moreau came in to inform the Board that the homeowner of 250 Winsor Street has not removed the debris from his property as he was informed to do by the Board members. Mr. Fontaine and Mr. Mendes will visit the property at 250 Winsor Street and speak with the homeowner.

- Mr. Paquette will discuss the unkept property of 14 Bucknell Street with Town Administrator Ellie Villano.

- Ludlow Public Health Nurse Cheryl Messer-Lusty would like to start teaching First Aid Training. In order to do this, we would have to purchase equipment. We can use the money that we have in the Nurses Donation account. Board members will invite Ms. Messer-Lusty to attend our next meeting to discuss this further.
