At 6:04 PM Mr. Haluch called the meeting to order in the Public Works conference room located a 198 Sportsman's Road.

All present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. John Bernardo and 11 other residents of McKinley Ave came in to discuss pavement conditions on the street. Mr. Frederick discussed with them what the Town has been doing to help remedy the situation.

Mr. Linton made a motion and Mr. Simao seconded to put McKinley Avenue on top of the list for Chapter 90 this year.

End of year budget and encumbrance. Transfers were approved. Amy is gathering the encumbrance list that is due within the week.

Local 98 labor position vacancies. BPW would like to view the applications once received from Human Resources.

Center Street project-The start date is July 9, 2018. Notifications on the start dates will be put into the Ludlow Register on a frequent basis to alert the residents as well as media outlets such as Channels 22 & 40 and the Town Website and Town Cable access.

Lunch punch situation-The matter needs to go through the Town labor collective bargaining to resolve. Suspended until further review from the Union.

Holyoke Street project. Paving is completed. Some touch ups near driveways as well as pavement markings are needed.

First Meeting House oil tank has been removed.

West Street paving project has had paperwork resubmitted for final payment and to close out.

Snow and Ice Budget gone through.

State Street project information was sent through email and the concept plans were plotted. Verification on several matters regarding the project to be looked into including, will Riverside Drive become a public way?

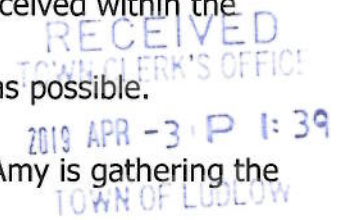

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The next BPW meeting will be 7/16/18.


At 8:03 PM, Mr. Haluch made a motion, seconded by Mr. Linton, to adjourn. The Board voted All in Favor.
