
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS DPW Conference Room 198 Sportsman's Road, Ludlow, MA 01056 MEETING MINUTES December 1, 2020



*Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 order suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law, MGL c. 30A Section 18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 order imposing strict limitations on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Ludlow Board of Public Works will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible.

Mr. Santos called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. All present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

OPERATION SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: We have been having issues with overflow parking at the Reservoir. We cut 2 locks off of our gate. We tried to coordinate the days their gate was open to ours but Monday morning our gate was zip locked. We cut it and removed half the gate. Last year we installed a new sidewalk in front of 36 Newbury Street. Resident at that address is having some water problems. He asked the Board to go out and take a look. Down To Earth is having trouble finding the same light pole for the Library. Maybe we can use something that was damaged on East Street. We only got one more additional snow contractor and no sidewalk plows. We lost 5 pieces from last year. Working on getting routes set up. He is not going to have contractors show up to the garage. They will report directly to their routes. He spoke w/ Mike Callahan @ Beaver Solutions. They are in the process of getting permits from the Board of Health and Conservation. Sale of lots-residents \$1,000, non-residents \$1,200. Effective January 1. Mr. Linton second. Send all funeral homes a letter letting them know. All in favor. Mr. Simao asked Mr. Santos to find out where the money is going when it's taken in for burials. Heavy duty truck exclusion previously discussed. No update on Transfer Station fees. New stickers have been ordered for the Transfer Station. No update on Electric Park drainage.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Davis said Amy Kurtz resigned yesterday. Mr. Santos has had the position posted internally for 1 week, then externally for 2 weeks. Mr. Soares asked who signed payroll this week.
