At 6:00 PM Mr. Santos called the meeting to order. All present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

CORRESPONDENCE:

#1090 – Letter from the Safety Committee – Aldo Drive – The Safety Committee discussed and voted 6-0 to have a mirror placed at the end of Aldo Drive due to line of site issues. It was requested that the Board of Public Works, install a mirror as budget allows. A pole and mirror will be installed. A motion was made to file by Mr. Simao, seconded by Mr. Ouellette. Vote 4-0 all in favor.

#1091 – Letter from the Safety Committee – 271 East Street – The Safety Committee discussed temporary removal of two parking spots in front of 271 East Street. After approval from the Board of Selectman at their meeting on April 26th the Safety Committee recommends the Department of Public Works place jersey barriers in front of 271 East Street. It is in hope that it will create better line of site and deter any accidents and hazards. The barriers will remain in place for ninety days. Mr. Santos would like to send a letter to the owner of 271 East Street letting them know that temporarily due to safety concerns they are putting two jersey barriers in front of the property. A motion was made to send a letter to the owner of the property at 271 East Street by Mr. Simao, seconded by Mr. Ouellette. Vote 4-0 all in favor.

#1092 – Letter from Stephen M. Reilly, Jr., Reilly Associates, and LLC – Trash fee for Southview Estates Condominium, Paradise Creek Condominium, Pondview Manor Condominium – The current trash fee was billed to the condominium association, not the unit owners. They are asking that the individual unit owners be billed. The Board previously discussed this matter after the FY2021 was issued. They decided going forward that the condominium complexes that had dumpsters would be billed to the association but complexes that had barrels would be billed to each unit owner. Mr. Santos to speak with Joe at the Assessors office to see if this was an oversight and to get it corrected. A motion was made to file by Mr. Simao, seconded by Mr. Ouellette. Vote 4-0 all in favor.

DIRECTORS REPORT:

Waste Management Contract – The contract has been approved by the town's attorney, it is now in the hands of Waste Management's attorney.

Sweeper Update – We are still waiting on freight charges.

Eversource did their moratorium repairs. All the patches were milled, paved, crack sealed and line striped. They did a great job.


There has been a few issues at Veterans Park School, quite a bit a vandalism. We have assisted in boarding up the entries that were broken.


NOTES AND COMMENTS:
