The Committee met with Ken Batista, Operations Supervisor and Steve Santos, BPW Member to discuss the DPW requested items.

1. Looking for the 4th sander/salter dump truck. This vehicle is 23yrs old, parts are no longer available. It is one of the four first response trucks. It would have a certain bed and is used as a regular dump truck in off season.
2. Looking to refurbish the vacuum sweeper... The cost of a new one is \$248,000 but the refurbishing of the transmission and motor rebuild would be approx... \$55,000 and give the vehicle another 7 years of life. They are requesting \$78,000 in case there is a conflict with the transmission and they need to be replaced. Liquid salt is 30% more corrosive.

E. Villano/Selectmen presented the estimated costs for the carpet project and the painting of the town hall (outside). The cost for the outside painting would be approx... \$32,000 and the cost of the carpet would be approx... \$60,000. Quote on the carpets to be provided by the next meeting.

D. Cincone representing the School requested that the capital project for the tennis court lights and the new truck be removed and replaced with the purchase of the wheelchair lift needed at the Ludlow High School. Estimated costs are \$32,000
