The meeting is taking place to review and vote on the Articles presented in the Town Meeting Warrant, for the Center Street Rehabilitation Project. The reason for the Special Town Meeting is that there is a timeline for the State deadline. The precinct members received all the background information outlining exactly where the takings will be made.


