The majority of overtime is related to maintaining minimum staffing in the building 24 hours a day 7 days a week. There is also some overtime incurred for mandatory training. The volume of calls has been also increasing over the last few years. The committee discussed the possibility of offsetting some of the overtime by hiring additional staff. From the Police Department Lieutenant Brennan and Lieutenant Irwing also discussed their department's overtime. The majority of overtime is also incurred for mandatory training as well as unexpected injuries. The committee also deliberated on the possibility of offsetting some of the overtime by hiring additional staff. Afterwards, Mr. Strange reviewed the budget calendar and the budget process. Ms. Lombardi and Mr. Kelliher also went over what was discussed during last night's joined Board of Selectmen, School Committee and Finance Committee meeting. The School Committee discussed next year's budget challenges which included salary renegotiations, out of district tuition and transportation.
