New Business

- Vote to approve meeting minutes for 10/5/20 Library Board of Trustees meeting
 - Passed
- Attendance
 - Total Library Visitors: 660 (Month of October)
 - Curbside pick-up visitors: 469 (we believe this number slightly declined due to the novelty wearing off and patrons not coming down each time an item arrives for them but rather waits until there is a bundle before coming down.)
 - In-person visitors: 191
- Programming
 - Adult Programming Stats:
 - Programs offered=3
 - Attendance= 8
 - Youth Services Programming for month of September
 - Total # of juvenile programs: 26
 - Attendance in juvenile programs: 179
 - Total # of YA programs: 11
 - Attendance in tween & teen programs: 79
