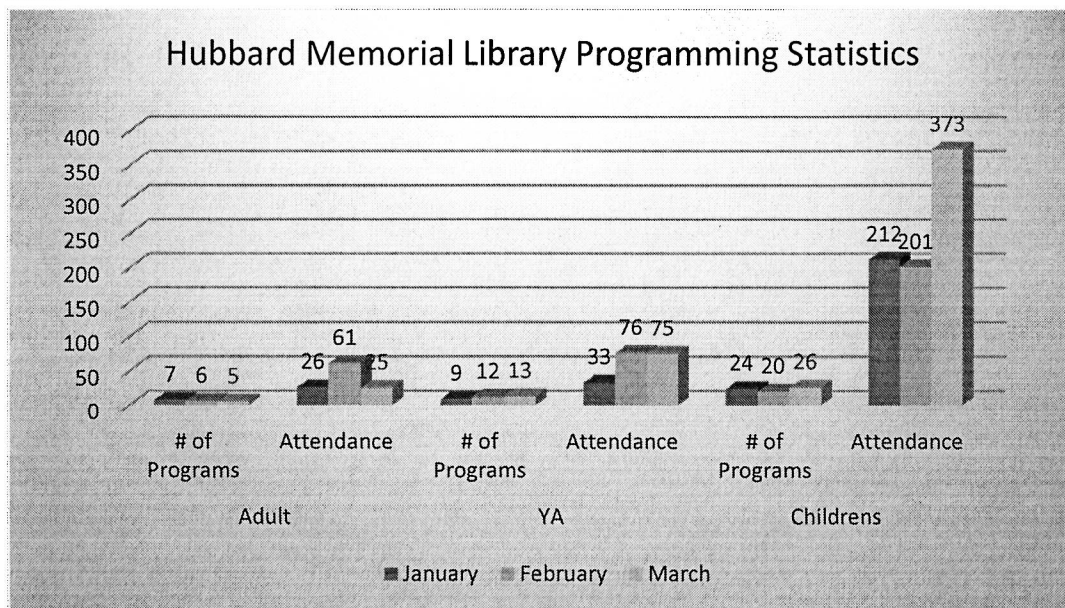

- Collection Development
 - Weeding is ongoing
 - Executed new agreement with Baker & Taylor for a Sustainable Shelves program which lets us have Baker & Taylor either provide a 15% credit for materials or have the items re-housed / recycled.
- Digitization
 - Met with Historical Commission to obtain their permission to:
 - Received archival supplies and a storage cabinet on behalf of the Historical Commission
 - Provided a copy of the key to John Moll from the Historical Commission
 - Completed transfer of the photograph / document / monograph collection to the Local History area in the library
 - Will begin process once cabinet has been received
 - Received the cabinet from Accounting (dated August 28, 1917)
