2. Acceptance of the minutes from June 20, 2019

Upon a motion made by Audrey Polmanteer, which was seconded by Patricia Holley, it was unanimously voted to accept the June 20, 2019 minutes, after amending section 4 and changing that Audrey Polmanteer seconded the motion, not Susan Stanek, as written. All in favor

A. Offline Houses: FISH # 161075

229-231 Howard Street in final prep stage to be rented. We have one side overhoused to transfer and have been working on CHAMP list to find tenant for other side.

We received the approval to move forward with the sale of 7 Maple Street & 668 Center Street. The attached RFP is for your review and approval. It has already been approved through Pau McPartland (DHCD). We also received additional funding so we can replace both units.

Motion made by Audrey Polmanteer, which was seconded by Patricia Holley, it was unanimously voted to sell 7 Maple Street and 668 Center Street, and to replace both units. All in favor

Motion made by Patricia Holley, which was seconded by Susan Stanek, it was unanimously voted to accept the RFP for both houses and have it go live as of July 31, 2019. All in favor

B. Roof Replacement 667-4: FISH # 161096 Roofs and insulation complete. It was found that the gutters needed to be replaced at a cost of 22,000. This went to DHCD as a change order and was approved. Old gutters were removed and replaced with new leaf guard gutters. Project completed.

Motion made by Susan Stanek, which was seconded David Sepanek, it was unanimously voted to acknowledge and accept the change order, Certificate of Substantial completion and the Certificate of Final Completion and payment of FISH # 161096. All in favor
