Mr. Linton stated that the Director of the Department of Public Works is getting pricing for moving the crosswalk on East Street.

Sgt. Shameklis thanked the Department of Public Works for installing the signs on the curve on West Avenue.


Mr. Churchill stated that there have been many complaints on Sunset Ridge of vehicles tearing up the road. He stated the Police Department is patrolling the area.

Mr. Churchill also stated that there are two flashing speed limit signs on Alden Street. The Police Department feels that these signs will give valuable traffic information for this area.


Mr. Linton made a motion, seconded by Mr. Simao, to adjourn at 5:50 p.m. Vote 7-0 all in favor




