OPEN DISCUSSION:



Mr. Churchill stated that the signage at the intersection of Chapin Street and Swan Avenue has been posted on a utility pole and is it facing an awkward direction so drivers cannot see it properly.


Mr. Churchill stated that he would like to see line painting or signage in the parking lot for the Police Department, specifically the area leading behind the building. That area is for authorized vehicles only and they are finding that residents are parking there and also walking behind there. It should be a restricted area. He has spoken to the Chief and he is looking into it.

Mr. Churchill stated that the traffic mirror located on East Street at Lower Whitney Street is broken and needs to be replaced. Mr. Simao stated he would bring it to the attention of the DPW.


Ms. Lebel made a motion, seconded by Mr. Coelho, to adjourn at 5:43 p.m. Vote: 7-0 all in favor


