ARTICLE 6: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from available funds a sum of money to be applied to close-out a number of deficit balances in old special articles accounts and capital projects from the Fiscal Years 1999 to 2009; pass any vote or take any action relative thereto. Submitted by the Board of Selectmen.

ARTICLE 7: To see if the town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury a sum of money to cover the town's obligation arising out of the settlement of pending litigation; pass any vote or take any action relative thereto. Submitted by the Board of Selectmen.

ARTICLE 8: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury and/or from free cash sufficient funds to cover the additional over time expenses incurred by the Police Department; pass any vote or take any action relative thereto. Submitted by the Board of Selectmen.

ARTICLE 9: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury a sum of money not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to cover a deficit in the Fire Department Personal Services Budget Account; pass any vote or take any action relative thereto. Submitted by the Board of Selectmen.
