The DPW would like to remind residents that next weeks' recyclables are paper and cardboard. Transfer Station permits are available. License and Registration is required. The fee is \$20.00 for residents and free for anyone 62 yrs. and older. All Trash information is updated and available on the town's website. According to the States figures, Ludlow had 299 positive Covid-19 tests from Dec. 27<sup>th</sup> thru Jan. 9<sup>th</sup> with 2814 tests being conducted. The Board of Health reports that there were 146 new cases last week. Please remember that the restrictions limits and reduced gathering limits that went into effect on Dec. 26<sup>th</sup> have been extended to at least Jan. 24<sup>th</sup>.
