

Town of Ludlow – Press Release

This weeks' Important messages for our community.

The DPW would like to remind residents that next weeks' recyclables are glass, plastics and containers. Transfer Station permits are available.

According to the States figures, Ludlow had 104 positive Covid-19 cases from Jan 31st thru Feb.12th with 121 positive test results from 2134 tests being conducted. Please visit www.mass.gov/info-details/covid-19-state-of-emergency

The walk-up windows are open at the Town Hall for the Collector and Board of Health and at the DPW normally from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 pm., Monday thru Friday. If you need assistance in any other department, please call ahead to schedule an appointment. Starting March 1st, the Town Clerk's window will be open for dog licensing Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9 to 3 for two weeks weather permitting. Any requests for certified copies of births, deaths, and marriages are by appointment only.

The Town has been notified by the State that we will not be receiving vaccines at this time for the first shot. The State is concentrating its efforts on mass sites and regional sites. Effective February 18th, individuals age 65 or older, individuals with two or more specific medical conditions and residents and staff of public and private low income and affordable senior housing are eligible to receive this vaccine. To schedule an appointment for the State run vaccine site located at the Eastfield Mall, please visit www.mass.gov/covid-19-vaccine-in-massachusetts. or call 2-1-1 for assistance.

The Senior Center is assisting those that are 65 and over with booking their COVID vaccine. Please call 583-3564 Monday – Friday, 8am-4pm. Please realize that the Center is in the middle of its move to the new site. If you need assistance in scheduling your vaccine, you must leave your name and number. Someone will get back to you but it may take a week. You are strongly encouraged to try and schedule your own appointment. While the building remains closed to the public, the Senior Center is staffed to assist you. The van will begin running again next week. Transportation is on Mondays, Wednesday and Fridays for in-town transportation. Please call the Center for more information.
