This weeks' Important messages for our community.

The DPW would like to remind residents that next weeks' recyclables are cardboard and paper.

According to the States figures, Ludlow had 77 positive Covid-19 cases from Feb. 7th thru Feb.20th with 94 positive test results from 2063 tests being conducted. Please visit www.mass.gov/info-details/covid-19-state-of-emergency

The walk-up windows are open at the Town Hall and DPW normally from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 pm., Monday thru Friday. If you need assistance in any other department, please call ahead to schedule an appointment. Starting March 1st the Town Clerk's window will be open for dog licensing Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9 to 3 for two weeks weather permitting. Any requests for certified copies of births, deaths, and marriages are by appointment only.

Effective March 1st, the Governor will place the state in Phase III, Step 2 of the reopening Massachusetts Plan. This means Indoor performance venues such as concert halls, theaters, and other indoor performance spaces will be allowed to reopen at 50% capacity . All sectors with capacity limits will be raised to 50% and exclude employees Restaurants will no longer have a capacity limit and will be permitted to host musical performances with all other protocols in place.

Effective February 18th, individuals age 65 or older, individuals with two or more specific medical conditions and residents and staff of public and private low income and affordable senior housing are eligible to receive this vaccine.
