The DPW would like to remind residents that next weeks' recyclables are paper and cardboard.

According to the States figures, Ludlow had 112 positive Covid-19 cases from Feb. 28th thru March 6<sup>th</sup> with 126 positive test results from 2311 tests being conducted. This puts our community in a HIGHER category which may cause a roll back of the reopening plan. We ask that resident remain vigilant. Now is not the time to start being lax.

The Veterans Healthcare System will be offering the Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 Vaccines to Any VA ENROLLED Veteran, of any age on Tuesday, March 16th at the Ludlow Lodge of Elks, located at 69 Chapin Street in Ludlow. Due to the high demand of appointments, Vaccines will be administered by appointments only from 9AM-3:00PM. No walk-ins will be accepted. Veterans are urged to call to schedule an appointment before close of business on Monday. The Vaccine appointment phone number is 413-582-3110. Please do not be discouraged if no one answers right away. The VA phone line does not have an automatic answer/wait feature. Please just call back. Veterans who need information about enrollment or how to enroll in the VA is asked to call the Veterans Office at 413-583-5600 x1290.

Please remember the Town Hall is still closed to the public however the walk - up windows for Town Hall and DPW are open from 9:00a.m. to 3:00 p.m. - Monday thru Friday. If you need assistance in any department, please call ahead to schedule an appointment.

The Senior Center is staffed. The van continues to run on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays for in-town transportation. The Grab and Go lunch program runs on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.
