The DPW would like to remind residents that next weeks' recyclables are paper and cardboard.

Our community remains at a LOWER category. According to the States figures, Ludlow had 81 positive Covid-19 cases from March 7th thru March 20th with 95 positive test results from 2147 tests being conducted. We ask that residents remain vigilant. As we continue with this positive trend, please remember to wear your masks and practice social distancing.
