Good Evening this is Andrea Crete, Health Agent for the Ludlow Board of Health giving you a weekly update on Covid 19 in the community. From April 11th to April 20th we had a total of 69 cases of Covid 19.

We encourage everyone, if you are experiencing any COVID Type symptoms including symptoms similar to seasonal allergies, do not attend a sporting practice or school before being tested to avoid exposure to others. Also, if your child was exposed, we encourage you NOT to send your child to school until you have spoken to the school nurse. With this week being school vacation, we ask that people be mindful of social gatherings.

As of April 13th, 25% of Ludlow Residents are now fully vaccinated.

We are currently in Phase 4 step 1 of the re-opening MA plan. All businesses must follow the guidance from the State pertaining to their establishment. Compliance with Covid 19 workplace standards for each business is the responsibility of the business owner to ensure that they are meeting all the requirements of the standards and Orders put in place by State authorities.
