This is not a time for social gatherings and activities. The severity of the Coronavirus is very real – not just in the world – but also in our Ludlow community. It should be stressed that it is everybody's responsibility in the community to adhere to social distancing of 6 feet, staying home when sick, self-quarantining when necessary, and taking personal precautions like handwashing. It should be assumed if you go out into the community that you are putting yourself at risk because anyone could have this and may not be showing symptoms.
