DPW would like residents to know that this upcoming week recyclable products will be glass, plastics and metals.

From the Board of Health - As of this week, we have 3 new cases of Covid -19. Protect yourselves from EEE (Eastern Equine Encephalitis: A neighboring town is rated at CRITICAL risk which puts Ludlow at MODERATE risk. Try avoiding doing outdoor activities before dawn or after dusk, and use mosquito repellent when needed.

The Thompson Memorial State Pool is now open to the public Monday, 8/24 – Thursday, 27/20 from 12:00-7:00pm at 2-hour intervals, first come first served.

Town Clerk – Early Voting for the September 1, 2020, State Primary will take place at the Town Hall on August 22, 2020 and August 23, 2020 Saturday and Sunday 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and August 24, 2020 through August 28, 2020, Monday – Friday 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

The last day to register to vote and change your party enrollment before the September 1, 2020, State Primary is Saturday, August 22, 2020. We will have in-person voter registration sessions from 2-4 and 7-8 behind Town Hall at the open window. Ballots can be dropped off at the drop box behind Town Hall on the left side of the double doors.

Due to early voting dog licenses will be extended until September 11, 2020, without incurring a late fee. The window behind Town Hall will be closed until September 2, 2020. Dog licenses, births, marriages, and deaths can still be obtained through the mail and should be requested ahead of time by contacting the Town Clerk's office. Thank you.
