DPW would like residents to know that this upcoming week's recyclable products will be plastics, metals and glass. The Transfer Station **will** be open Saturday Sept 5 8:00 a.m.-2:50 p.m. Trash and recycling **will not** be picked up on Monday September 7. The trash schedule will be one day delayed.

- Since last Friday we have had 4 new covid cases in Town (Overall number is 153).
- EEE Update: Chicopee, East Longmeadow, Ludlow, Palmer and Springfield have continued to be raised to "moderate" risk for EEE – try to limit time outdoors before Dawn and after Dusk, wear mosquito repellent if you do go out during those hours.
