The DPW would like to remind residents that the week of Sept. 21 -25 recycle bottles/cans/containers will be collected curbside.

From the Board of Health:

This week we have had 5 new cases of Covid-19 in Ludlow. According to the state dashboard, Ludlow has a decrease in new cases and the status has been changed to "Lower".

The Board of Health Nursing Department is looking to hold another "Drive-Thru FREE mask event" in mid-October. We are asking again for our talented crafters to help, if you can. Police Department - During the past six days the Ludlow Police Department has received nine reported incidents involving bicyclists or off-road vehicle operators causing disturbances by driving erratically or through loud noise complaints.

The bicyclists and/or off-road vehicle operators either speed, create loud noise disturbances by driving through residential neighborhoods, weave in-between vehicle traffic, or deliberately swerve at motorists either in parking lots or on public roadways. These incidents have occurred on West St. by Holyoke St., Chestnut St. by East St., Howard St. by Sewall St., East St. by Prospect St., Ridgeview Cir., Minechoag Heights, and Fox Run Dr.

The Ludlow Police Department encourages anyone who observes this type of behavior to contact the Ludlow Central Dispatch Center as quickly and as timely as possible to help us identify the operators.

These bicyclists and off-road vehicle operators may be charged both criminally or civilly for their illegal driving behavior, and they may also face confiscation or impoundment of their bicycles or off-road vehicles.
