This weeks' Important messages for our community.

The DPW would like to remind residents that next weeks' recyclables are containers, glass and plastic. Town residents are encouraged to use the temporary overflow parking for the Ludlow Reservoir Recreation Area located on the town owned property adjacent to the reservoir.

The DPW will begin a resurfacing project on Winsor Street from East Street to Stevens Street and Warren Street in its entirety starting Monday October 5, 2020. Project hours will be from 7:00 am thru 5:00 pm daily and run thru the end of the month. There will be a parking ban in effect for the outlined construction areas the entire month from 6:00 am thru 6:00 pm every day except Sunday.
