

Good evening, this is Mike Lafever, Chairman for the Ludlow Board of Health. I would like to give the community an update for the month of November. We have a total of 304 confirmed positive cases of Covid 19 for the month. Ludlow is now in its second week in High Risk Status.

Ludlow is in High Risk due to the volume of cases of Covid 19 exceeding a State determined maximum threshold of 5% increase in positive cases in a two-week period.

One more week of being in High Risk means that the Town moves back to Step 1 in Phase 3.

Through our Contact Tracing we have learned that the COVID-19 virus is changing and is not causing many of the symptoms we saw in April. Many people are asymptomatic and not showing any symptoms. We do not know what the virus is going to be like come Spring 2021, which is more reason to be on guard and protect yourself against exposure to this virus.

Do not give the virus ANY chance to infect you!

- Wash your hands often and especially after going out in public and touching any common use objects
- Wear a mask in public and around other people not from your household REGARDLESS of social distancing
- Continue to keep social distance of 6ft or more
- Avoid gatherings and activities that promote group participation and contact
- Stay home when feeling ill
- GET TESTED! Know your status!
